ORDINANCE #11-2014

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER XV OF THE REVISED
GENERAL ORDINANCES OF THE BOROUGH OF ROSELAND
ENTITLED SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT BY AMENDING SECTION
15-2.3 ENTITLED MANDATORY SEPARATION AND AMENDING
SECTION 15.28 ENTITLED ADMINISTRATION AND ENFORCEMENT**

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Roseland, County of Essex, State of New Jersey as follows:

SECTION 1 – That section 15-2.3 Mandatory Separation shall be amended to **add** the following:

15-2.3 Mandatory Separation and Reporting.

d. Prior to March 1 of each year, occupants of all Commercial and Institutional establishments, multi-family housing owners or their agents shall report, on forms provided by the municipality, to the Municipal Recycling Coordinator, the tonnage of recyclables collected and removed from the municipality during the previous year.

SECTION 2 – That section 15-2.8 Administration and Enforcement shall be amended to **delete** the following and **add** the following:

15-2.8 Administration and Enforcement.

~~This section will be administered by the various appropriate officials of the Borough so empowered by the regulations duly adopted by the Mayor and Council.~~

The Code Enforcement Official, the Department of Health, the Recycling Coordinator, the Property Maintenance Official, the Housing Officer, the County Department of Health, and such other Borough employees as may be designated by resolution of the mayor and council are hereby individually and severally empowered to enforce the provisions of this Ordinance. An inspection may consist of sorting through containers and opening of solid waste bags to detect by sound or sight, the presence of any recyclable material.

SECTION 3 – If any section or provision of this ordinance shall be invalid in any court the same shall not affect the other sections or provisions of this ordinance except so far as the section or provision so declared invalid shall be inseparable from the remainder or any portion thereof.

SECTION 4 – All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

SECTION 5 – This ordinance shall take effect upon publication as provided by law.




