DECLARATION OF EMERGENCY WATER MAIN BREAK
ON JANUARY 22, 2018 AND AUTHORIZING EMERGENCY
CONTRACTS FOR THE REPAIRS TO 1 KINCAID COURT, 17
PITCAIRN DRIVE AND 79 LAUREL AVENUE

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 40A:11-6 et seq. provides that a municipality may enter into an emergency contract for purchase of service without competitive bidding or obtaining of quotes, provided that an emergency exists that effects the safety, health and welfare of the citizens of the Borough of Roseland; and

WHEREAS, at approximately 8:30 am, Sunday, January 21, 2018 the Assistant Superintendent of Public works received a phone call from the Essex Fells Water Department of possible water main break on 1 Kincaid Court; and

WHEREAS, FSC Leak Detection services was called out to trace and mark the main and the break. FSC showed up at approximately 10:30am and completed their work by 12:30 at which time a second break was detected on Pitcairn Drive. FSC assisted in locating the second break and left for the day; and

WHEREAS, while all of the crews were working on the west end the police department was notified of another suspected break, this time on the opposite end of town Laurel Ave. The Department of Public Works responded to the location and confirmed the break and called Carner Brothers to see if he was available to dig and repair the Laurel Ave break. Carner Brothers was on site at 1:30 and began working; and

WHEREAS, all breaks resulted in a singular circular crack on pipe which was Cast Iron Pipe 8" in diameter and were all repaired with a single bank stainless steel Smith Blair wrap; and

WHEREAS, Martin Excavating was used to assist with the repair of the main line in front of 17 Pitcairn Drive. Roseland DPW repaired the break in front of 1 Kincaid Court and the last break reported was repaired by Carner Brothers in front of 79 Laurel Avenue; and


NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Governing Body of the Borough of Roseland approve the following:

1. The emergency contract with Martin Excavating used for the repair on 17 Pitcairn Drive


2. The emergency contract with Carner Brother used for the repair on 79 Laurel Avenue
3. The emergency contract with FSC Leak Detection to determine the location of the leak
4. All labor charges for the DPW and Police associated with the emergency be charged to the emergency
5. Any action taken by the Chief Financial Officer, is hereby approved and authorized involving the water main repair
6. The within resolution is subject to the availability of funds.
