

CAPITAL ORDINANCE STATEMENTS AND SUMMARY

PUBLIC NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Capital Ordinance No. 16-2017, the summary terms of which are included herein, has been finally adopted by the Borough Council of the Borough of Roseland, in the County of Essex, New Jersey on December 11, 2017, and the twenty (20) day period of limitation within which a suit, action or proceeding questioning the validity of such bond ordinance can be commenced, as provided in the Local Bond Law, has begun to run from the date of the first publication of this statement. Copies of the full bond ordinance are available at no cost and during regular business hours, at the Borough Clerk's office in Municipal Building to the members of the general public who shall request the same. The summary of the terms of such bond ordinance follows:

Title: AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF ROSELAND, IN THE COUNTY OF ESSEX, NEW JERSEY, PROVIDING FOR REPLACEMENT OF POLICE EQUIPMENT IN AND FOR THE BOROUGH AND APPROPRIATING \$43,000 TO FUND THE SAME.

Purpose(s): The replacement of equipment used by the Borough's Police Department, including but not limited to Camera Flashback System, Tough Book Computers, Semi-Automatic Rifle and Equipment and Antenna Radar System, including all work and related materials necessary therefor and incidental thereto, there is hereby appropriated the sum of \$43,000 from the Borough's Capital Improvement Fund.

Appropriation: \$43,000

Debt Authorized: None.

Grants Appropriated: \$0.
