

ORDINANCE NO. 22-2019

**BOROUGH OF ROSELAND
COUNTY OF ESSEX, STATE OF NEW JERSEY**

ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$63,000 FROM THE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND FOR THE ACQUISITION OF THREE VEHICLE PLATE READERS FOR THE POLICE DEPARTMENT IN AND BY THE BOROUGH OF ROSELAND, IN THE COUNTY OF ESSEX, NEW JERSEY

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOROUGH COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF ROSELAND, IN THE COUNTY OF ESSEX, NEW JERSEY AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I

\$63,000 is hereby appropriated from the Capital Improvement Fund of the Borough of Roseland, in the County of Essex, New Jersey (the "Borough") for the acquisition of three vehicle plate readers for the Police Department, including all related costs and expenditures incidental thereto.

SECTION II

The Borough hereby certifies that it has adopted a capital budget or a temporary capital budget, as applicable. The capital or temporary capital budget of the Borough is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this ordinance to the extent of any inconsistency herewith. To the extent that the purposes authorized herein are inconsistent with the adopted capital or temporary capital budget, a revised capital or temporary capital budget has been filed with the Division of Local Government Services.

SECTION III

This ordinance shall take effect after final adoption and publication and otherwise as provided by law.




