APPROVAL OF PROPOSAL FROM MASER CONSULTING TO
PREPARE A TRAFFIC IMPACT STUDY FOR 85 LIVINGSTON
AVENUE AND 6 BECKER FARM ROAD

WHEREAS, on February 20, 2018, the appointment of the firm of Maser Consulting as Borough Engineer was made through the Fair and Open Process using the Request for Proposal Procedure of the Local Public Contracts Law as provided in N.J.S.A. 19:44A-2-.4 et seq. as a professional service; and

WHEREAS, fees for capital projects, tax map updates, GIS maintenance, environmental services, geotechnical engineering, and traffic studies, engineering or planning studies and reports will be billed in accordance with the fee schedule on a lump sum basis contained in their attached proposal and only upon prior approval of the Mayor and Council and certification of available funds by the Chief Financial Officer; and


WHEREAS, Maser Consulting submitted a proposal to prepare a traffic impact study to evaluate the effect of proposed residential development at 85 Livingston Avenue and 6 Becker Farm Road on a cost-plus basis not to exceed \$19,500.00; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to N.J.A.C. 5:30-5.4 et seq., the Chief Financial Officer has certified funds in the amount of \$19,500.00 under PO 18-00286 and charged to budget account 8-01-20-155-090;


