



RESIDENT REMINDER

Under Board of Health Ordinance, all mature (7 months old) dogs and cats must be counted and licensed by the Borough. Licenses have to be renewed by February 28, 2017. All animals are required to show proof of current rabies vaccination good through October 31, 2017. Proof of neutering/spaying is also required in order to obtain exemption from extra fees. Basic dog license fee is \$10.00; \$13.00 if not neutered/spayed. Cat fee is \$8.00. Late fees are assessed at \$5.00 per animal for applications filed after the designated due date.
