Each bid must be furnished on the proposal sheets included in the Contract Documents, enclosed in a sealed envelope and addressed to the Borough Clerk, Borough of Roseland, 140 Eagle Rock Avenue, Roseland, N.J. 07068, and plainly marked on the outside with the name and address of the bidder and the Contract Number and Title.

Mailed responses will be held and opened at the above specified time and date. No bids are to be sent via regular mail. The Borough is not responsible for late delivery by any postal carrier.

This contract will be awarded by the Borough through a public bidding process complying with the requirements of the Local Public Contracts Law, N.J.S.A. 40A:11-1 et. seq. as well as with the New Jersey Local Unit Pay-to-Play Law, N.J.S.A. 19:44A-20.4 et. seq.

The successful bidder shall be required to comply with the provisions of the New Jersey Prevailing Wage Act, Chapter 150 of the Laws of 1963, effective January 1, 1964.
