COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES

The September 20, 2022 meeting of the Roseland Mayor and Council was called to order at 6:30 PM by Mayor Spango. Adequate notice of the meeting was provided in accordance with the Open Public Meeting Act in that the date, time and location of the meeting were included in the Annual Meeting Schedule, sent to the official newspapers, posted on the public bulletin board in the Municipal Building and filed in the office of the Borough Clerk. This meeting was also available via Zoom conference call.

EXECUTIVE SESSION

Councilman Freda made a motion to approve Resolution No. 261-2022 Approval to Close to Executive Session to discuss the following:

The motion was seconded by Councilwoman Perrotti and approved by a 3-0 voice vote (Bardi, Tolli, and Trillo absent). Councilman Trillo arrived shortly after the beginning of executive session. Council adjourned executive session at 6:50 PM. Mayor Spango read the Sunshine Statement again at 7:00 PM and called the meeting to order. Clerk Watkins called the roll noting that Councilman Bardi and Councilwoman Tolli were absent.

Honorary Mayor Andrew Mercadante led the salute to the flag.

SWEARING IN CEREMONY

Mayor Spango administered the oath of office to Honorary Mayor Andrew Mercadante.

Mayor Spango administered the oath of office to Acting Police Director John A. Matheis.

PRESENTATIONS

Mayor Spango invited members of the police department and fire department that were present, to join Council at the front of the meeting room. Mayor Spango asked OEM Coordinator John Matheis to elaborate on the events of a recent, serious house fire at the home of Mark and Cherie Castellano on Thackeray Drive. Mr. Matheis explained that members of the fire department rescued the family dog "Cruiser" from the house and resuscitated the dog. Members of the police department transported the dog to the emergency hospital where Cruiser was treated. Mayor Spango asked Cherie Castellano, accompanied by Cruiser, to come to the podium to address the audience. Mrs. Castellano thanked the police officers and firefighters for their efforts at the fire, and particularly with saving Cruiser's life. OEM Coordinator Matheis, police officer Dylan Hughes, police officer Jason Hiter, OEM Coordinator John Matheis, and Fire Chief Richard Loveless were given citations for their efforts at the fire. Chief Loveless accepted the citation on behalf of all members of the fire department.
