The Mayor is considered the CEO and only votes in the case of a tie. The Council considers and sets policies to govern the Borough of Roseland in accordance with statutory authority. They are responsible for adopting the budget and enacting ordinances to regulate the affairs of the municipality.

The Borough Clerk's position is a statutory appointment that requires certification by the State of New Jersey in Election, Ethics, Finance, Licensing and Records Management. The Municipal Clerk attends council meetings, preserves good public relations, acts as liaison between the Governing Body and the public, and serves as the municipality's elections official.

The following are some of the responsibilities of the office of the Borough Clerk: Secretary of the Municipal Corporation; Secretary to the Governing Body; Chief Administrative Officer of Elections; Administrative Officer; Records Coordinator and Manager; Other Duties As Required.

### ELECTION INFORMATION

The Borough Clerk is available on all Election days to answer questions and assist Essex County Officials in ensuring that each election runs as smoothly as possible. If you wish to change your party affiliation, change your address, or receive a vote-by-mail application, the Borough Clerk's office can also assist you to complete those steps.

You can register to vote if you are a United States citizen, you will be 18 years of age by the next election, you will be a resident of the State and county 30 days before the election, and if you are NOT currently serving a sentence, probation or parole because of a felony conviction. To find out if you are already registered to vote please call either the Essex County Board of Elections at (973) 621-5070 or the Borough Clerk's Office at (973)-403-6029.

Those living in District #1 & 4 vote at the All Purpose Room at 19 Harrison Avenue. Those living in District #2 & 3 vote at the Roseland First Aid Squad Building. District #5 & 6 will continue to vote at the Roseland Public Library. A list of what streets are in which district is available on the Voting & Election Information page on the Municipal Clerk webpage on the Borough website.

### GARAGE SALE PERMITS

A permit is required to hold a Garage Sale in Roseland. Prior to issuing a Garage Sale Permit, the individual conducting the sale shall file an application with the Borough Clerk at least 5 days in advance of the proposed sale. There is an administrative processing fee of \$5.00 for the issuance of a permit. The Garage Sale Permit application is available on the Municipal Clerk webpage on the Borough website.

### PUBLIC RECORDS REQUESTS (OPRA)

New Jersey law allows for residents to seek documents under the Open Public Records Act (OPRA), unless specifically exempt. A request for access to a government record under OPRA must be in writing, hand-delivered, mailed, transmitted electronically, or otherwise conveyed to the appropriate custodian. The seven (7) business day response time does not commence until the records custodian receives the request form. If you submit the request form to any other officer or employee of the Name of Agency, that officer or employee must either forward the request to the appropriate custodian, or direct you to the appropriate custodian. The Borough's OPRA Request Form is available on the Municipal Clerk webpage on the Borough website.

### BINGO/RAFFLE LICENSING

Qualified Organizations must obtain a license from the Borough of Roseland in order to conduct a 50/50, bingo, or any type of raffle. The organization must have a valid registration from the State of N.J. Legalized Games of Chance Control Commission prior to submitting an application to the Borough of Roseland. ### VOLUNTEER FOR THE BOROUGH OF ROSELAND

Any Roseland resident wishing to serve on a Borough Board, Committee, or Commission may fill out a Citizen Leadership Form either online or in person and return to the Borough Clerk's Office. Forms may be found online on the Borough website under the "How Do I?" tab. A list of boards, committees, and commissions are available on the Borough website.

### NOTARY SERVICES

The Municipal Clerk's Office has a Notary and will provide Notary Services free of charge. Please call Ashley Kennedy at (973)-403-6024 or email [akennedy@roselandnj.org](mailto:akennedy@roselandnj.org) to make an appointment. A current documentation of identification is required and the documents needing notarization must be signed in the presence of the Notary. Please do not sign the document until you are in front of the Notary.

### DOG AND CAT LICENSING

Dog and cat licensing is conducted each year during the months of January and February. A late fee is charged for any license not renewed by the end of February.

In your envelope to drop off, please include your payment, license application, a stamped and self-addressed envelope, and proof of rabies vaccination. Per N.J.A.C. 8:23A-4.1, any rabies certificate that expires before November 1 of the current licensing period must be renewed before a license can be issued. If the dog/cat was vaccinated at the Roseland Rabies Clinic, give the date of vaccination. Include proof of neutering/spaying if not submitted previously. If your dog/cat is neutered/spayed and you cannot located proof, please contact your veterinarian immediately to get the paperwork required. Checks should be addressed to "Borough of Roseland".

Licensing of new dogs can be done at any time during the year and a late fee will not be charged. We require dog and cat license renewals to be done via the mail. The license and tag will be mailed to the owner. License applications and fees may be mailed to the Borough of Roseland, Attn: Dog/Cat License, 140 Eagle Rock Avenue, Roseland, NJ 07068. ## Happy Independence Day

from the Borough of Roseland

IN CONGRESS, JULY 4, 1776.

The unanimous Declaration of the thirteen united States of America.

When in the Course of human events, it becomes necessary for one People to dissolve the political bands which have connected them with another, and to assume among the Powers of the earth, the separate and equal station to which the Laws of Nature and of Nature's God entitle them, a decent Respect to the Opinions of Mankind requires that the Reasons which impel them to the Separation should be published to the world and that they should solemnly declare to all Mankind the Causes, on which alone they justly claim to pull apart from the former, and to assume among the Powers of the earth, the separate and equal station to which the Laws of Nature and of Nature's God entitle them.

We the Representatives of the United States of America, in General Congress assembled, do hereby declare that these United States are, and of right ought to be, free and independent States; that they are absolved from all Allegiance to the British Crown, and that all political connection with them is, and ought to be, totally dissolved; and that as Majorities of the United States have assumed the standard of Liberty, they now, by the unanimous Declaration of the thirteen united States of America, do hereby sever all political connection with the said Kingdom of Great Britain; that the United States are, and of right ought to be, free and independent States; that they are absolved from all Allegiance to the British Crown, and that all political connection with them is, and ought to be, totally dissolved; and that as Majorities of the United States have assumed the standard of Liberty, they now, by the unanimous Declaration of the thirteen united States of America, do hereby sever all political connection with the said Kingdom of Great Britain.

The Public Works Department handles maintenance and repair of Borough roads and buildings, coordinates garbage and recycling schedules, and handles special pickup of branches, leaves, bulk and metal goods for the community. The mission of the Roseland Department of Public Works is to maintain, repair, and wherever possible, improve the infrastructure of our community. This would include the municipal roads, sidewalks, parking lots, parks, trees, buildings, sewers and also maintain the municipal fleet and to do this in the most efficient manner as possible. This department will strive to continue to provide the high level of service Roseland residents expect and deserve from their Public Works Department.

**SUBMIT AN ONLINE WORK REQUEST**

Residents who would like to submit a work request to the Department of Public Works can use the new online form to notify the Borough about a variety of potential issues. Inquiries and submissions of issues in your community regarding the following topics can be completed through this form: New Meter Program, Sanitary Sewer Issue, Request a UCC Inspection, Litter Issues, Property Maintenance, Garbage Complaint, Potholes, Request a Final Water Reading, Storm Related Damage, and Water Pressure Issues.

This form can be found on the Borough website, [www.roselandnj.org](http://www.roselandnj.org), in two places. You can go to the Government tab, select Public Works, and then click the Public Works Request button OR you can go to the How Do I? tab and under the Submit header, click Public Works Request.

**BRANCH, LEAF & VEGETATIVE WASTE**

The Department of Public Works begins collection of branches for chipping the first Monday of each month, January through October. There will be no branch collection for the months of November and December of each year due to the leaf collection program. Pickups may be delayed due to the number of stops and/or weather conditions. Branches must be a minimum of 1" in diameter, 3' long and not exceed a maximum of 4" in diameter and 10' long. Branches must not be tied and should be placed on the lawn area as close to the curb as possible. Branches are NOT to be placed in the road. Logs, roots & stumps CANNOT be collected.

Vegetative waste such as grass clippings, shrub cuttings & twigs ARE NOT picked up with your regular household trash or for bulk pickup. The Public Works Department will pick these items up curbside on Wednesdays from April through October of each year. Bio-degradable paper bags are preferred. Reusable containers must be 32 gallons or less in size. Plastic bags will NOT be collected.

Commencing in the middle of October, for a period of approximately eight weeks, Public Works provides mechanical curbside collection of loose leaves on **BOROUGH** streets. Residents on these streets can rake their leaves into the curb area during this time period only. As an alternative, residents may also use paper bags. Residents on **COUNTY** roads MUST bag their leaves for Borough collection and receive twenty-four (24) free paper bags per year. Paper bags may be purchased at anytime during the year at the Public Works Office and are picked up on Wednesdays. Plastic bags will not be collected.

Branch, leaf, and vegetative waste items should be placed at the curb after 8pm the night before the scheduled pickup day. Appointments are NOT needed for any branch, leaf, or vegetative waste pickups.

**GARBAGE**

Roseland residents have twice a week garbage pickup year-round with collection dates based on your side of town. In case of a holiday, pickup is skipped until the next regularly scheduled garbage collection day. Residents who reside in Section 1 have their garbage picked up on Mondays and Thursdays, while residents who reside in Section 2 have their garbage picked up on Tuesdays and Fridays. Garbage and recycling should be placed at the curb after 8pm the night before the scheduled pickup day. A listing detailing the Borough's streets and sections is available on the Public Works webpage on the Borough's website.

All residents have recyclable pickups every Wednesday with alternating weeks between paper/cardboard and commingled recycling. Recycling is mandatory in the Borough of Roseland. Residents must use the curbside pickup as Roseland does not have a recycling center.

For **paper and cardboard** recycling days, residents can put out newspaper, magazines, catalogs, office paper, junk mail, telephone books, corrugated or flat sheet stiff paperboard. Paper must be tied in bundles or placed in paper bags not to exceed 30 lbs. in weight. Cardboard must be tied in bundles not to exceed 3 feet wide by 3 feet long and 18 inches high. It will be picked up at the curb along with each regularly scheduled newspaper collection; however, it must be separated from the newspaper. Gift & cereal boxes are not considered cardboard and are not recyclable. Plastic bags or cardboard boxes are not to be used to bundle paper and cardboard recycling. Hard and/or soft cover books and computer paper are not recyclable and should be put out for Bulk collection.

For **commingled** recycling days, residents can put out glass, aluminum, tin and plastic food and beverage containers. Also included in plastic items are shampoo, detergent and other household cleaning containers. All commingled items must be washed and/or rinsed clean and placed in reusable containers not to exceed 50 lbs. in weight. Paper bags or cardboard boxes are not to be used. Mirrors, window glass, light bulbs, aluminum foil and trays, crystal, ceramic cups and plates, drinking glasses, and plastic toys are not recyclable.

**Bulk Collection** is on the second Wednesday of each month. AN APPOINTMENT IS NOT NECESSARY. These items include, but are not limited to: Furniture, Non-Metal Shelving, Mattresses & Box Springs Vacuum Cleaners, Sinks, Tubs & Toilets, Rolled Carpeting, and Shower Doors. Certain items are considered hazardous waste and must be disposed of through a State licensed hazardous waste contractor; for example oil-based paint, pesticides, herbicides, motor oil, fluorescent bulbs, car batteries, anti-freeze, turpentine, aerosol spray paints, driveway sealer, and propane tanks. **Metal Collection** is on the last Wednesday of each month BY APPOINTMENT ONLY. Appointments must be made any time prior to 3:00 p.m. the TUESDAY before the last WEDNESDAY by calling 973-226-6565. These large metal items include, but are not limited to: Water Heaters, Rims Without Tires, Washers & Dryers, Barbecue Grills (without propane tank), Refrigerators & Freezers, Wrought Iron Furniture, Dishwashers & Stoves, Boilers & Furnaces, Lawnmowers without Tires, Air Conditioners, Bicycles Without Tires, TV Antennas, Disassembled Metal Sheds, and Metal Piping/Storm Doors.

Our garbage contractor, Joseph Smentkowski Carting, collects the bulk and metal materials. Their contract with the Borough does not require them to collect construction materials generated from renovations and/or alterations (sheetrock, lumber, shingles, windows, doors, tile, concrete), tires, fencing, vehicle parts, tree trunks/stumps/roots and rocks and/or dirt. The Borough of Roseland does not have a dumping site.

The Recreation Department handles sports leagues, programs, special events and oversees the Borough's recreation and park facilities. The Recreation Department runs various sports, in addition to several competitions, senior events, and public events every year. They are constantly looking into new ideas and improving and adding programs as the years go on, so please contact the Recreation Department to receive the latest information on what programs and events are being offered.

### FACILITY USE PERMITS

The Borough of Roseland grants outdoor facility permits to any person, group, associations or organization for the purpose of sports games, practices, picnics, parties or theatrical or entertainment performances, or any other activity that promotes recreational, educational or cultural opportunities for Roseland residents. If you wish to use one of our outdoor or indoor facilities, you need to fill out our Facility Use Packet and receive a signed permit back. Permits must be submitted to the Recreation Office. Permits may be issued for Monday through Saturday from 9:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. or dusk during weekdays. Sundays shall be limited to 10:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. or dusk. The Facility Use Packet is available on the Recreation Department page of the Borough website or can be picked up in-person at Borough Hall.

### COMMUNITY ACTIVITIES & SPORTS OPPORTUNITIES

The Borough of Roseland works with other communities and organizations in the area in order to provide additional services to Roseland residents that the Borough cannot provide. Programs such as Field Hockey, Golf, Football, Cheerleading, and VVrestling are typically available for Roseland families to take advantage of. For a complete and current list of available programs offered to Roseland residents from neighboring municipalities and private sports organization, visit the Recreation webpage on the Borough website or contact the Recreation Department.

### COMMUNITY PASS

The Borough uses Community Pass, an online registration and payment service, to allow residents to sign up for Borough events and Borough recreation programs. If you cannot pay online and must pay by cash or check, you will need to register and pay in-person at the Recreation office located at 140 Eagle Rock Avenue, Monday through Friday between 8:30am and 4:00pm. Residents are highly encouraged to sign up for and to utilize the Community Pass system.

For those that are using Community Pass for the first time and are unsure what to do and how to create an account, a step-by-step video is available on the Borough website and the Borough's YouTube account.

### ROSELAND SENIOR SOCIETY

Senior programs offered through the Roseland Senior Society are organized through the Recreation Department, but are decided upon by the Senior Citizen Advisory Board. Seniors wanting to get involved in planning trips and events should volunteer to join the Senior Citizen Advisory Board. Senior Society meetings are held the 2nd and 4th Fridays each month, usually at the Roseland Free Public Library.

### BOROUGH PARKS

The Borough is fortunate to have several parks and fields for residents to enjoy. Some of these parks are owned and maintained by the Borough while others are County owned properties or operated in conjunction with other communities.

### YOUTH & ADULT PROGRAMS AND ANNUAL EVENTS

Youth Programs run annually by the Recreation Department include basketball, baseball, softball, T-Ball, and soccer. New sports are being explored and are offered all of the time, and residents are encouraged to voice their ideas to the Recreation Department for new programs and sports that can be offered. Competitions run annually by the Recreation Department include Pitch, Hit & Run, Fishing Derby, Jr. Olympics, Soccer Shoot, and Hoop Shoot.

Adult Programming includes softball, basketball (winter and summer), kickball, and pickleball. There are occasional programs where parents are invited to participate in activities with their children as well, including Father/Child Bowling and Multi Sports Squirrels.

Annual family events put on each year by the Borough or in conjunction with neighboring communities include the Easter Egg Hunt, Opening Day Baseball/Softball Parade, Memorial Day Parade, Community Picnic, Independence Day Fireworks, Run for Roseland, Junior Olympics, Community Bonfire/Movie Night, Christmas Tree Lighting/Santa Arrival, and Menorah Lighting Celebration.

### SUMMER PLAYGROUND PROGRAM (SCRAM)

SCRAM (Sports, Crafts, Recreation And Music), which is also known as the "Summer playground program with the camp atmosphere", is a six week program running from late June to early August. The program is held from 8:30am-3:30pm weekdays, excluding federal holidays. Children participate in various activities such as sports, crafts, in-house events and entertainment, as well as trips. There is a registration requirement and a fee to participate in SCRAM.

### PROPERTY TAX PAYMENTS

Property tax bills are **mailed out once a year** which will include four stubs. Bills usually are sent out over the summer once the new tax rate has been officially approved. The new bills will cover the 3rd and 4th quarter of the current year and the 1st and 2nd quarter of the following year.

The **1st Quarter** lasts from January-March with payment due by **February 1**. The **2nd Quarter** lasts from April-June with payment due by **May 1**. The **3rd Quarter** lasts from July-September with payment due by **August 1**. The **4th Quarter** lasts from October-December with payment due by **November 1**. There is a 10 day grace period for payments. If Borough Hall is closed on the 10th day of the grace period (due to weekend or holiday), they will be due the next business day.

Amounts owed can be found and paid online at the Borough website by going to [www.roselandnj.org](http://www.roselandnj.org) and clicking the Online Bill Pay button. Please note that no partial payments are accepted online. Bills can also be paid at Borough Hall during business hours (8:30am - 4:30pm) or placed inside the locked dropbox.

If you are looking for information or assistance in regards to certain property tax benefits, like disabled persons, veteran deductions, and disabled veteran property tax exemptions, you will need to contact the Tax Assessor's office at 973-403-6044 or by emailing [taxassessor@roselandnj.org](mailto:taxassessor@roselandnj.org). Please note that the Tax Assessor comes in only on Fridays, so a response could take up to 5 business days to receive.

### WATER/SEWER BILLING

Water/Sewer bills are mailed out quarterly with **payment due within 30 days of the billing date**. There is **no grace period for water/sewer bills**. All bills include a flat \$100 meter/sewer fee. Anything over the \$100 fee is the fee for additional water usage.

The **1st Quarter** bill measures usage from **October-December of the previous year**. The **2nd Quarter** bill measures usage from **January-March** of the current year. The **3rd Quarter** bill measures usage from **April-June** of the current year. The **4th Quarter** bill measures usage from **July-September** of the current year.

### SENIOR FREEZE & ANCHOR PROPERTY TAX PROGRAMS

Residents with questions and those interested in applying for the Senior Freeze program should call the State hotline at **1-800-882-6597**. Those with questions and wanting to apply for the ANCHOR Benefit Program should call **1-877-658-2972**.

### FINAL WATER METER READINGS

When selling your property, residents and business owners **MUST** have performed a final water meter reading before their closing. This will ensure that the new owner's name will appear on the future water bills and not the seller's, so the seller is no longer charged going forward. ### EMERGENCY NOTIFICATION SYSTEM

To provide more reliable communications with residents and businesses in Roseland, the Borough has established an emergency alert system through CivicReady to send phone calls and alerts to those who sign up.

CivicReady in a nutshell is a system that makes phone calls, sends text messages, and sends push alerts to specific people or areas in the event of an emergency or for sharing important information. All calls or messages you receive will come from the telephone number 973-557-6889. If you are want to receive these notifications, texts, and phone calls, please fill out the form on the Borough website at [www.roselandnj.org](http://www.roselandnj.org) and click the button in the footer that says "CivicReady Emergency Notifications". Residents are encouraged to download the free, accompanying mobile application available on the Google Play & Apple Stores.

### REMEMBER TO "LOCK"!

Residents are asked to remember the acronym LOCK once they arrive at home at the end of their day. LOCK, which stands for Lock Overnight and take Car Keys, is an important action to take as there have been numerous reports of car thieves and car break-ins in Roseland and in surrounding communities. By leaving valuables, car keys, money, and important documents in plain view, thieves are more likely to attempt to break into your vehicle. Some incidents have even occurred where thieves were able to simply enter a vehicle parked in a driveway as it was left unlocked.

### INTERNET TRANSACTION SAFE ZONE

Roseland has created a safe location to conduct sales transactions that originate on the internet that residents are encouraged to utilize. This location is in front of the Roseland Police Station and has a live video surveillance camera that is also recorded. There is a sign by a parking spot in front of the police station indicating this location.

### PROJECT MEDICINE DROP BOX

The Borough wants to assist residents in fighting against the nationwide epidemic of opiate and heroin abuse. Working with Attorney General's office, the Police Department has installed a Project Medicine Drop located in the Police Department lobby. This convenient drop allows our residents to securely dispose of unused or excess medication 24 hours a day. We should all do our part to battle this serious issue plaguing our nation. The medicine drop box is located in the lobby of our police station at 15 Harrison Avenue and it provides our residents a safe and secure method of disposing of unneeded medication.

### PAY PARKING OR TRAFFIC TICKET ONLINE

Anyone receiving a traffic ticket in the Borough of Roseland can pay their ticket using NJMCDirect - a fast, secure, convenient way to access your traffic ticket information online. You will need your parking or traffic ticket, your license plate number, a Visa or Mastercard, and the Municipal Court Code ID - which for Roseland is 0718.

### FIREARMS APPLICATION & REGISTRATION SYSTEM

Anyone who owns or wants to own a firearm in the State of New Jersey must fill out an application and register their firearm. Residents who are unfamiliar with this process should contact the Police Department at 973-226-8700 to receive assistance in complying with the processes and procedures required.
